Jesus' Model Prayer

When you pray, **OUR FATHER** - Acknowledge God and who He is. He is Almighty God, Creator, Comforter, Potter, Heavenly Father, Source, True and Living God, Precious Lord, Shepherd, Maker, Hope, Strengthened, Holy One, Deliverer, Savior, Righteous Father, Shield, Jehovah, Bread of Life, Way, Truth and the Life. **WHO ART IN HEAVEN** - Acknowledge where God is. Our God is in Heaven and we need His divine help. **HALLOWED BE THY NAME** – We worship you Lord, for there is none like you. We exalt you Lord for you are worthy to be praised. Magnify and Glorify God. God you are Love, Joy, Peace, Faithful, Holy, Peace, Good, and Gentle. **THY KINGDOM COME THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN** – Desire that God's purpose and will be done in the lives of others, that the lost and weak may receive salvation, that we serve others, that we feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and pray for the sick. Pray that our leaders hear from God and seek His wisdom and instruction. Pray that God gives us the courage to stand at all times, to trust, believe and fear Him above anything else. Pray for our children, our homes, and to be led by the Holy Spirit. Desire to live for God and develop a closer relationship with Him. **GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD** – Thank God for His Son, our Savior Jesus Christ who died for the sins of the whole world, for supplying all of our needs on a daily basis. Thank God for the air we breathe, for strength in our bodies, for life, clean water, that we have food to eat, clothes to wear, and a place to lay our heads and call home. Thank you God for waking us up to new mercies every day. Thank God for everything and take nothing for granted. **AND FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US** - We must confess our sins daily and ask God and other for forgiveness. We are praying and asking God to forgive us from lying, nasty attitudes, to separate us from the sinful ways of the world, to have good relationships with family, friends, co-workers and our neighbors. Lord, teach us to let go of hurt, anger and bitterness. Ask God to give you a clean heart and a rightful spirit. Let us repent from sin and ask God to cleanse our hearts. **LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL-** Acknowledge that God is a deliverer. We pray for His Wisdom and Guidance continually for He knows the way in which we should go. As Christians we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, spiritual wickedness in high places. Pray and thank God for the armor that He wants us to put on before we go out each day. **FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER AND THE GLORY** - Acknowledge that God has all Power to rule the affairs of men and that all the Glory belongs to Him.

BIBLE STUDY TIME

Help Through Prayer

I Thessalonians 5: 17, 25 “Pray without ceasing”, “Brethren, pray for us”

2 Corinthians 1:3-11

Prayer –an act of communion with God, as a confession, praise, or thanksgiving; a reverent petition made to God.

What is prayer to us? Prayer is a duty. It is one of the various tasks that God has given to every believer to accomplish on a daily basis. Yet, prayer is often one of the most selfish areas of Christians’ lives. Most prayers center on ones personal needs or those they know very well. We need to learn how to reach beyond our own narrow concerns and pray for others. Many times we tell people we will pray for them and we don’t. When we do remember, we pray once and then forget. We all need to stop and examine our prayer lives and keep in step with the scriptures.

We must take time and seek God to tell us the direction He has for our lives. We need to cry out to God to keep us holy, to help us have dominion over sin, to help us become Christ like, to help us receive guidance for living, to give us His anointing. We can enjoy sweet communion with Him, quietly worshipping Him and being refreshed in His presence. We can ask the Lord to protect our children from the schemes of the devil. We can ask Him to keep our sons like oak trees planted by the river of God. We can ask Him to keep our daughters polished stones in his palace. We pray for our mates and ask for love and commitment in our relationships. We pray for our churches. We intercede for individuals who are in crisis and for the missionaries and ministries we support.

However, sweet communion for ourselves and others that we know is not enough. We must learn how to pray seriously/earnestly for the dire needs of **all** those around us. We need to develop the kind of blessed prayer life that is truly a “helper in prayer”.

There are many people suffering whose greatest anguish is mental, caused by ill treatment from those they’ve loved and helped. David reflected in his psalms that “He grieved over friends who turned against him without cause, people he’s fed and provided for at his own expense”. There are some that have been wounded by the sword in the back from those they loved and respected.

David said in Psalm 55:21, “the words of his mouth were smoother than butter, but war was in his heart: his words were softer than oil, yet were they drawn words.” In times like this, the need for a “prayer helper” is great and intense.

There are times when people have no strength left to fight the powers of the darkness. Paul felt this way (2 Corinthians 1:3-10). Paul’s trial had brought him to the end of his endurance. God marvelously delivered (vs. 10) “He has delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver, in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us”

How was Paul delivered?

- ❖ First Paul was delivered because he was a mighty man of prayer.
- ❖ Secondly Paul had great confidence in God
- ❖ Third Paul had and needed “prayer helpers”

In verse (2 Corinthians 1:11) Paul models God’s approach to ministry by letting the Corinthians’ know that they are so important that he has a need for their prayers. We have to know that someone always needs our prayer, even when they tell us they don’t want them.

- ❖ Prayer is that important, because God said it is. It doesn’t cost but a few seconds or moments to lift up someone to God.
- ❖ Prayer and deliverance are inseparable.
- ❖ (Psalm 50:15) “Call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me”
- ❖ (Psalm 91:15) “He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him”
- ❖ Paul was so conscious of his need for prayers of the saints; he pleaded for “prayer helpers” everywhere. He begged Romans, “Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ’s sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in your prayers to God for me; that I may be delivered” (Romans 15:30-31).

- ❖ When Paul used the word strive he was using the Greek work “struggle”. Paul was saying struggle with me as a partner in prayer; wrestle for me in prayer.” Paul wasn’t asking for a quick mention to the throne. He was pleading, “Fight for me in prayer. Do spiritual battle, both for my sake and the sake of the gospel.”
- ❖ Your prayers not only help people and situations; they also help spread the gospel. Because people are delivered through prayer they tell everyone what God has done.
- ❖ Pray without ceasing. Psalm 55:17 “I will pray morning, noon, and night.”

Some thoughts from others on PRAYER:

- ❖ Matthew Henry - “Prayer must be kept up as duly as meat-time”.
- ❖ Adoniram Judson - “God answers all true prayer, either in kind or in kindness.”
- ❖ Thomas Watson - “Prayer is the soul’s breathing itself into the bosom of its heavenly father.”
- ❖ Andrew Murray - “The great thing in prayer is to feel that we are putting our supplications into the bosom of omnipotent love.”
- ❖ John Bunyan - “Prayer is a shield to the soul, a sacrifice to God, and a scourge for Satan.”
- ❖ Dwight L. Moody - “If we do not love one another we certainly shall not have much power with God in prayer.”
- ❖ E.M. Bounds - “The more praying there is in the world, the better the world will be; the mightier the forces against evil everywhere.”
- ❖ Vavasor Powell - “A saint is to put forth his faith in prayer, and afterwards follow his prayer with faith.”
- ❖ J. C. Ryle - “We must wrestle earnestly in prayer, like men contending with a deadly enemy for life.”
- ❖ Adoniram Judson - “Our prayers run along one road and God’s answers by another, and by and by they meet.
- ❖ Martin Luther - “Prayer is a strong wall and fortress of the church; it is a godly Christian’s weapon.”
- ❖ J. C. Ryle - “A mans state before God may always be measured by his prayers.”
- ❖ Proverbs 15:27 - “The Lord is far from the wicked, but he hears the prayers of the righteous.”
- ❖ Frederick Denison Maurice - “The Lord’s Prayer may be committed to memory quickly, but it is slowly learnt by heart.”
- ❖ Francis Fenelon - “Even if no command to pray had existed, our very weakness would have suggested it.”

We must remember that God is able to do everything, except fail. Thus, we must be committed to our task, which is to pray, pray and pray more. We must become “Prayer helpers”.

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The Five Finger Prayer

The “Five Finger Prayer” is a simple, yet effective, way to pray. Begin your prayers by praying for those closest to you.

THUMB – CHILDREN, SPOUSE, PARENTS, FRIENDS, NEIGHBORS, CO-WORKERS, ENEMIES

Matthew 5:44 :”But I say unto you, Love your enemies, Bless them that curse you, do good to them that despitefully use you, and persecute you.

POINTING FINGER – TEACH, INSTRUCT, HEAL – DOCTORS, TEACHERS, PASTORS, MINISTERS

Ephesians 1;17-18 – I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so you may know him better.

Romans 10:15a – How Beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things.

TALLEST FINGER – LEADERS, PRESIDENTS, POLICE, MILITARY, LEADERS IN GOVERNMENT AND INDUSTRY, ADMINISTRATOIRS

Hebrew 13:17a – Obey them that have rule over you.

RING FINGER – WEAK, SICK, HURTING, THOSE IN PAIN AND TROUBLE

2 Corinthians 1:4 – who comforteth us in all our tribulations, that we may be able to comfort them which are in trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.

LITTLE FINGER – CONFESS SINS, THANK GOD FOR ALL HIS BLESSINGS, PRAY FOR GOD’S WILL, FAITH TO PERSEVERE, COURAGE –LASTLY PRAY FOR YOURSELF

1 John 1:9 – If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

12 Steps to Change Your Prayer Life

Right to the Heart of Women (Men)

1. "The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD; He directs it like a watercourse wherever He pleases." (Prov. 21:1)

If your thoughts wander during your prayer time, instead of trying to force them back into your pre-set agenda, try following them. Perhaps the Lord has another agenda.

2. "But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen." (Matthew 6:5-6).

Set a time for daily prayer. Consider it an unbreakable commitment. Keep your set appointment every day for one week. For one solid week, let your scheduled prayer time be the centerpiece of your day; arrange everything else to fit around it.

3. "Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed." (Mark 1:35)

Give God the first fruits of your day. For one week, give the very first 30 minutes of your day to prayer.

4. "But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed." (Luke 5:16)

Find a place in your home where you can be alone and undistracted during your prayer time. Keep your Bible, prayer journal, pen, and whatever tools you use in that place so that everything is ready. During your prayer time each day, this is a sacred place.

5. "I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple." (Isaiah 6:1)

As you start your prayer time, before you say anything, let your mind's eye see Him, high and exalted, and yourself in a position of worship before Him. Stay in that inner posture until His glory fills your thoughts as the train of His robe fills the temple.

6. "But Jesus said, 'Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me.'" (Luke 8:46)

Take time to become truly alive to His presence with you. Be aware that as you touch Him through prayer, His power is released into your life.

7. "O my people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth." (Psalm 78:1)

Read your Bible this morning with the awareness that you are listening to the words of His mouth. Stop at the first word, phrase, or thought that captures your attention and let the Father speak to you about it and let it shape your prayers.

8. "We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand." (Isaiah 64:8)

This week, practice the prayer of pliability. Instead of focusing on what you want God to do for you, focus on allowing Him to shape your desires until they match His. Accept each situation in your life as His hand shaping your thoughts, character, and longings.

9. "Not my will, but yours be done." (Luke 22:42)

This week, let these words be the only prayer you pray about situations that confront you. Focus on relinquishing every situation to Him to be a platform for His power.

10. "I will remember the deeds of the LORD." (Psalm 77:11)

This week, try writing out your prayers. It will help you stay focused and will create a record of God's work in your life.

11. "My tongue will speak of your righteousness and of your praises all day long." (Psalm 35:28)

This week, practice praying out loud during your private prayer time. It will make your prayer experience more concrete and will help you keep your mind focused.

12. "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; ...talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up." (Deuteronomy 11:18-20)

This week, try walking as you pray. Walk through your neighborhood or around your yard. You will be more able to keep your mind open to new thoughts the Lord might introduce. You are likely to find yourself spending more time with Him.

PRAY: Do Not Worry-He Will PROVIDE



(Matthew 6:25-33)

Matthew chapter six was part of Christ's Sermon on the Mount that He preached. In this particular passage of scripture, Christ is addressing the subject of worry.

Matthew 6:25 -- Jesus speaks on worry and anxiety. Jesus not only tells us worry and anxiety are both unnecessary and futile, He also gives us a godly remedy for and an alternative to worrying, by which we shall gain, without worrying, the very objects about which we were worrying. **"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear"** (vs. 25). Christ is telling us in this scripture to quit worrying over every thing. Do we have enough to wear? Do we have enough to eat and drink? He states, doesn't life have more than food and clothing? There are too many of us overly concerned with the rising economy. People are questioning if the gas prices will go back up. Many see the cost of their grocery prices sky rocketing.

Christ wants us to look at the big picture here. The most important thing that we should concern ourselves with is the condition of our souls. Have we repented, been baptized, and filled with His Spirit? Are we living according to His will? It says in the Bible, life is like a vapor, here today and gone tomorrow, the things of this world will some day pass away and what will truly matter is where we are going to spend eternity.

Matthew 6:26 -- Christ is using the birds as an example of God's provisions. He sees to it that the birds are taken care of. Not just the birds, but the animals of the fields, and the sea life. Think about that. God sends food for the little birds to eat. He provides drink for the animal in the wild. He doesn't forget these creations. If God doesn't forget any creature whether it is great or small, He will remember His children and provide for our needs.

Matthew 6:27 -- Certainly, worry accomplishes very little. And far from lengthening our lives, as we know from today's medical sciences, worry is much more likely to shorten our lives.

God will feed us, clothe us, and take us home when He chooses. Our worrying will not lengthen our lives. And we will not die until God has determined that our work is done.

Maybe you are not worrying about food/clothes, but maybe you are worrying about your job, your family, health, finances, and church, to name a few. Being doubtful and worrisome are true faithless acts. How can God allow us to be used for His glory or operate in His gifts if we can't trust Him with every aspect of our life- spiritual, mental, emotional, financial, and physical? He is a holistic God. He doesn't just provide for some needs but ALL needs. We tend to trust God in some areas and try to "take care of" other areas ourselves - Big mistake! We must learn to let God be in control and leave the details to Him.

Matthew 6:28-29 -- Even the flowers of the fields are beautifully arrayed. They depend on God for nourishment. The flowers could not survive without God being in control. The flowers are beautiful to the sight because God created, nourished them, supplied for their needs and made them beautiful to gaze upon. We take God and all of His blessings for granted. Again we are more important than any other creature, because we are His children, his creation.

Matthew 6:30 -- If God loves and cares for flowers that are only here for a moment, that have no soul, that are not His children, just think of what He will supply for those who love and care for Him, who praise His name, those who glorify and honor Him, and those who serve Him.

Matthew 6:31-33 -- God knows your needs. He will give you all you need but there is something that is required of us. We have to live for Him. WE must live for our Father and focus on our relationship with Him. There are so many awesome reasons to serve God. It is God's desire that all accept Him and serve Him.

The final thought in all of this passage is Matthew 6:34 - Don't worry and contemplate about the cares of tomorrow. Concentrate on today. Take one day at a time. We don't have the promise of tomorrow. Live each day the best way you possibly can. Treat people right and love unconditionally. Trust God to bring provisions and meet any need. Boldly approach the throne believing that God will see you through.

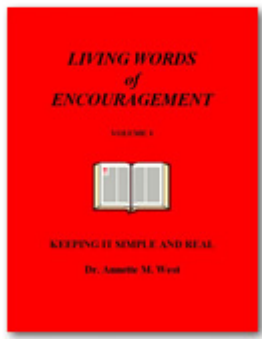
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Purchase the book online!
